BOOKING POLICY

Peavy for Governor 2026

Effective Date: March 2026 | Last Updated: March 2026

PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY

The Peavy for Governor 2026 campaign is actively booking community events, speaking engagements, town halls, church appearances, union meetings, school visits, media interviews, podcast appearances, and any gathering where California voters can hear this campaign's message directly from Ms. Peavy. This Booking Policy explains who can book, what types of appearances we accept, how the process works, what we provide at every appearance, what we ask from hosts, and how we confirm and manage all bookings.

This is a grassroots campaign with a real candidate who shows up. We do not send surrogates. We do not send video recordings in place of a live appearance without prior agreement. When you book Ms. Peavy you get Ms. Peavy.

WHO CAN BOOK AN APPEARANCE

The following organizations and individuals are welcome to book Ms. Peavy for an appearance:

Churches and faith communities of any denomination seeking a candidate forum, community conversation, or campaign appearance.

Labor unions, trade organizations, and worker associations who want to hear the campaign's position on worker rights, teacher pay, farmworker protections, and living wage enforcement.

Schools, colleges, and universities seeking a political speaker for students, faculty, or community members.

Neighborhood associations, block clubs, and community organizations hosting voter outreach events.

Black and Latino community organizations, civil rights organizations, and advocacy groups.

Political clubs, Democratic clubs, and civic organizations.

Businesses and small business associations who want to hear the campaign's position on corporate tax equality, the Prop 13 commercial loophole, and California's economic policy.

Media outlets, journalists, podcasters, broadcasters, and content creators seeking an interview or appearance.

Any individual hosting a house party, neighborhood gathering, or community event in their home or space.

Any organization not listed above that believes their community needs to hear this campaign's message before June 2, 2026.

TYPES OF APPEARANCES WE ACCEPT

Community Events and Town Halls

Open community gatherings where Ms. Peavy presents the campaign platform and takes questions from attendees. These events are free to attend. We provide a full presentation covering the reform platform, the civil rights family legacy, how to write in Ms. Peavy on June 2, and voter registration assistance. Recommended minimum attendance is 15 people. There is no maximum.

Church and Faith Community Appearances

Ms. Peavy is available to speak at church services, faith community gatherings, and religious organization events. We respect the separation of church and state and do not ask religious organizations to endorse the campaign. We ask only for the opportunity to be heard by your community.

Union Hall and Labor Organization Meetings

Ms. Peavy's father is a teachers union member. The campaign's commitment to teacher salary floors, worker protections, and living wage enforcement comes from a union family. We welcome invitations from any labor organization and will present the campaign's full worker rights platform at every union appearance.

School and Campus Appearances

We accept invitations to speak at high schools, community colleges, four-year universities, and graduate institutions. Presentations for student audiences focus on voter registration, write-in voting instructions, and the policy issues most relevant to young Californians including housing affordability, teacher shortages, clean water, and economic equity.

Media Interviews and Podcast Appearances

Ms. Peavy is available for television, radio, print, digital, and podcast interviews. We do not pre-screen questions. We do not require topic approval before confirming an interview. We do not use media handlers. For media bookings include your outlet name, your deadline, and the format. We respond within four hours during business hours.

Private Events and Fundraisers

Private events including campaign fundraisers and donor appreciation events may be booked through the same process. Contact us directly to discuss format, timing, and any specific requirements. All fundraising activity complies with California campaign finance law.

Virtual Appearances

For organizations outside the immediate Bay Area and Sacramento regions or for communities that prefer a virtual format, Ms. Peavy is available for Zoom, Google Meet, and other video conference platforms. Virtual appearances receive the same preparation and commitment as in-person appearances.

HOW TO BOOK

The booking process is straightforward and confirmation is guaranteed within 48 hours.

Step One: Contact us with the following information.

Your name and the name of your organization or event. Your location including city and specific venue if confirmed. Your expected attendance. Your preferred dates and any flexibility. The type of appearance you are requesting. Any specific topics, themes, or format preferences.

Step Two: We confirm availability.

We will respond within 48 hours to confirm availability for your requested dates. If your first choice dates are not available we will offer the nearest available alternatives.

Step Three: We confirm logistics.

Once dates are confirmed we will work with you on all logistics including arrival time, setup needs, audio visual requirements, voter registration table setup, and any accessibility accommodations your attendees require.

Step Four: We show up.

Ms. Peavy arrives on time, prepared, and ready to engage your community directly and honestly. No handlers. No scripts. No pre-approved questions. No limitations on what your community can ask.

WHAT WE PROVIDE AT EVERY APPEARANCE

The following is provided by the campaign at no cost to the host at every community appearance:

Ms. Peavy or a designated campaign representative. If a representative rather than Ms. Peavy will attend due to a scheduling conflict you will be notified in advance with sufficient time to adjust your event.

A full presentation of the Peavy for Governor 2026 reform platform covering housing, clean water, education, public safety, fiscal accountability, and economic equity.

Campaign materials including flyers, write-in voting instruction cards, and voter registration forms for every attendee.

Voter registration assistance at every event. The voter registration deadline is May 19, 2026. Every unregistered attendee can register on site.

Write-in voting instructions. Every attendee leaves knowing exactly how to write in Ms. Peavy on their Democratic Primary ballot on June 2, 2026.

Open question and answer time. Ms. Peavy takes questions from attendees on any topic. There are no pre-screened questions and no topics that are off limits.

WHAT WE ASK FROM HOSTS

We ask very little from the organizations and individuals who host our appearances.

Provide a safe, accessible space with enough seating for your expected attendance.

Promote the event to your community through your own channels at least one week before the date. The more people who attend, the more voters hear this message before June 2.

Ensure the venue is accessible to people with disabilities. If accessibility accommodations are needed inform us when booking and we will work with you to address them.

Allow the campaign to set up a voter registration table at the event. This is a non-partisan civic activity and is not a requirement of your endorsement or support of this campaign.

There is no fee to host a community event. There is no minimum donation required. There is no expectation that your organization endorses this campaign as a condition of hosting.

CANCELLATION AND RESCHEDULING

We understand that circumstances change. If you need to cancel or reschedule a confirmed appearance please contact us as soon as possible at (424) 459-6503 or PeavyGovernorCali2026@gmail.com. We ask for at least 48 hours notice when possible.

If the campaign must cancel a confirmed appearance due to an unavoidable conflict we will contact you immediately and offer to reschedule at the earliest available date. We take our booking commitments seriously.

ACCESSIBILITY AT ALL APPEARANCES

All campaign appearances are held in accessible venues whenever possible. If you or any attendee requires a specific accommodation including wheelchair access, sign language interpretation, large print materials, or any other accommodation, please inform us when booking and we will ensure those needs are met. Every California voter deserves access to this campaign.

MEDIA COVERAGE OF APPEARANCES

Media are welcome at all public campaign appearances. Press must identify themselves to campaign staff upon arrival. Photography and video recording of Ms. Peavy's remarks are permitted at all public appearances. BOOKING DEADLINE

The California Democratic Primary is June 2, 2026. The write-in candidacy filing deadline is April 24, 2026 at 5PM. The voter registration deadline is May 19, 2026. We are accepting booking requests through May 30, 2026. Events scheduled after May 19 will focus on get out the vote messaging and write-in voting instructions. We encourage all hosts to book as early as possible to secure your preferred date.
