OUR COMMITMENT TO TRANSPARENCY

The Peavy for Governor 2026 campaign is built on a single foundational promise: we will tell the truth. Not the political version of the truth. Not the version that tests well in a focus group. The actual truth, with the actual numbers, about what is happening in California and what this campaign will do about it.

This Transparency Statement explains who we are, where our money comes from, how we spend it, who makes decisions for this campaign, and how voters can verify every claim we make. We publish this statement because transparency is not a legal requirement we are complying with. It is a value we are demonstrating.

WHO WE ARE

Candidate: Ms. Peavy

Ms. Peavy is a Democratic write-in candidate for Governor of California in the June 2, 2026 primary election. She is the first African American woman and first Latina woman to run for Governor of California in the state's 175-year history. She is an African American and Latina woman of Puerto Rican heritage from Puerto Rico and Mexican heritage from Jalisco, Mexico. She is currently a resident of Oakland, California.

Campaign Committee: Committee to Elect Ms. Peavy Governor 2026

This campaign is operated as a California state political campaign committee registered with the California Fair Political Practices Commission. All campaign finance activity is reported to the FPPC as required by California law and is publicly available through the FPPC's online database at fppc.ca.gov.

WHERE OUR MONEY COMES FROM

This campaign accepts zero corporate funding. Zero. We do not accept contributions from corporations, political action committees, Super PACs, or any other organized money that represents institutional interests rather than individual voters. Every dollar raised by this campaign comes from individual people who believe California deserves better leadership.

All donations are processed through ActBlue, a federally registered fundraising platform used by Democratic campaigns and progressive organizations. ActBlue maintains its own transparency standards and all donations are traceable and publicly reported.

As required by California campaign finance law, all donations exceeding \$100 in a calendar year are reported to the California Fair Political Practices Commission. These reports are public record and are available to any voter, journalist, or researcher who wants to verify the sources of this campaign's funding.

We do not accept donations from foreign nationals. We do not accept donations from federal contractors. We do not accept donations from any source that would create a conflict of interest with our reform platform or our obligation to every Californian we are asking to trust us.

HOW WE SPEND CAMPAIGN FUNDS

Every dollar spent by this campaign is reported to the California Fair Political Practices Commission as required by law. Campaign expenditures cover voter outreach, campaign materials, event costs, digital platform costs, and the operational expenses of running a statewide grassroots campaign.

Ms. Peavy does not draw a salary from this campaign. No campaign funds are used for personal expenses. No campaign funds are directed to family members or associates for services not directly related to campaign operations. Every expenditure is documented and reported.

All FPPC-filed campaign finance reports for this campaign are publicly available at fppc.ca.gov. Any voter can look up this campaign's complete financial record at any time.

OUR POLICY CLAIMS AND HOW TO VERIFY THEM

Every statistical claim made by this campaign is sourced to a publicly available document. The following are the primary sources for the campaign's key policy statements:

\$24 billion spent on homelessness with the count increasing by 30,000 people: California State Auditor Report and California Interagency Council on Homelessness annual reports, publicly available at auditor.ca.gov.

OUR REFORM PLATFORM

The Peavy for Governor 2026 reform platform is published in full on this campaign's website. Every policy item includes an identified funding source. No policy item is listed without a corresponding revenue mechanism. This is a deliberate transparency commitment. Campaigns that list policies without funding sources are not being transparent about whether those policies are actually achievable. We are.

WHAT WE WILL NOT DO

This campaign will not publish misleading statistics. If a number is an estimate it will be identified as an estimate. If a range is possible it will be reported as a range.

This campaign will not accept corporate donations and then pretend to be independent of corporate interests. Our funding sources are our actual funding sources.

This campaign will not make policy promises that have no funding mechanism behind them. Every commitment in this platform is funded.

This campaign will not use political consultants who have a financial interest in inflating our polling numbers or misrepresenting our position in this race. We report the polls as they are, including polls that show us with work to do.

This campaign will not hide its candidate behind handlers, pre-screened questions, or controlled media environments. Ms. Peavy speaks directly. She answers directly. Every voter, journalist, and community member who wants to ask her a question will get a direct answer.

This campaign will publish all formal endorsements on its website as they are received. An endorsement listed on this campaign's website represents a genuine, voluntary expression of support from the endorsing individual or organization. We will not list endorsements that have not been explicitly given.

This campaign is a Democratic write-in campaign. Ms. Peavy is running in the Democratic Primary. This campaign is not affiliated with the Republican Party, any Republican candidate, any third party, or any organization that has not explicitly endorsed this campaign.
