Our Commitment

Peavy for Governor 2026 is committed to ensuring that our website is accessible to all Californians, including people with disabilities. We believe that every voter has the right to access information about this campaign regardless of ability, device, or assistive technology. Accessibility is not a courtesy. It is a right. And it is consistent with the values of equality and social justice that are at the foundation of everything this campaign stands for.

We are actively working to increase the accessibility and usability of our website and in doing so adhere to the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines issued by the World Wide Web Consortium. These guidelines explain how to make web content more accessible to people with disabilities.

Standards We Follow

We aim to meet the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines version 2.1 at Level AA conformance. These guidelines cover four principles of accessibility. First, content must be perceivable, meaning information must be presented in ways that users can perceive through their available senses. Second, content must be operable, meaning users must be able to operate the interface. Third, content must be understandable, meaning users must be able to understand the information and interface. Fourth, content must be robust, meaning content must be interpreted reliably by a wide variety of user agents including assistive technologies.

What We Are Doing

The Peavy for Governor 2026 campaign takes the following steps to ensure accessibility on this website:

All images on this website include descriptive alternative text so that screen readers can communicate visual content to users with visual impairments.

We use clear heading structures on every page so that users navigating by screen reader can understand the organization of content without visual cues.

All videos posted on this website or linked from this website will include closed captions or transcripts.

Color contrast on all pages is designed to meet or exceed minimum ratios required for users with visual impairments.

All buttons, links, and interactive elements are labeled clearly so that screen reader users can understand their purpose.

Our website is designed to be navigable by keyboard alone for users who cannot use a mouse or touchscreen.

Text on this site can be resized using standard browser controls without loss of content or functionality.

We review our website regularly for accessibility issues and address them as they are identified.

Known Limitations

We are a grassroots campaign with limited resources and our website is actively being built and updated. While we are committed to full accessibility, there may be some content that has not yet been fully optimized. We are working to address any gaps as quickly as possible. If you encounter a barrier on any page of this website, please contact us immediately and we will prioritize fixing it.
